National Security Minister Robert Montague says the Traffic Ticket Amnesty which was scheduled to start tomorrow, July 1, will begin on Wednesday August 2, 2017.

Minister Montague explained that the new start date is to ensure all systems are in place.

The amnesty will allow motorists to pay outstanding traffic tickets without attracting demerit points; giving them the opportunity to begin with a clean slate before the new Road Traffic Act is implemented.

The updated Road Traffic Act will repeal and replace the existing Road Traffic Act of 1938 and will establish new road traffic offences as well as provide increased penalties for current offences.
