JOB PURPOSE:

Under the direction of the Senior Director, Monitoring & Evaluation, Data & Research Analytics, the incumbent will be responsible for the preparation of research proposals and conducting research to prepare the relevant reports which inform policy recommendations.

The duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Assists in the identification of priority areas for research and presents skeletal outlines for consideration;
- Assists in the preparation of draft Annual Work Plan of research studies to be conducted for consideration:
- Assists in the Terms of Reference for approved research studies;
- Assists with the formatting of research documents, such as questionnaires, research proposals, research instruments and other related documents;
- > Develops and implements research quality control procedures:
- > Performs descriptive and multivariate statistical analyses of data, using computer software;
- Assists in the analyzing of in-depth interviews conducted with key stakeholders relating to researches being conducted;
- Assists in verification and background checks to ensure credibility and reliability of reports, etc.;
- Assists in reviewing relevant literatures;
- Assists in the preparation of summaries and abstract documents;
- Participates in meeting and workshops on strategic planning and policy issues;
- Stays abreast of trends and developments in the field of research and statistical analysis by participating in conferences, workshops and seminars; reading professional publications; maintaining professional networks; and participating in professional organizations;
- Prepares, manipulates, and manages extensive databases for work undertaken by the unit;
- Responds to external and internal research enquiries from colleagues, other government departments, academics, local councils, regional development agencies and members of the public;
- Performs other related duties and responsibilities as may be determined by the Director.
